
Notably, 2024's Rank 2 (Harshita Goyal) scored 144, a remarkably high essay score that surpasses all top-5 essay scores from 2023. In contrast, 2024's Rank 1 scored only 100 in Essay, significantly lower than the lowest top-5 essay score of 2023 (117). This suggests that in 2024, performance in the Essay paper was more uneven – one topper excelled exceptionally, while even the rank 1 topper had a relatively modest essay score.

The 2023 Rank 4 scored only 83 in GS1 – a noticeable dip – yet still secured a high rank overall by compensating in other papers (for instance, P. K. Sidharth had an exceptional optional score. Apart from that outlier, other 2023 toppers scored around 104–110 in GS1. 2024's GS1 scores (orange line) were a bit more uniform, ranging from high 80s to low 110s. The top scorer in GS1 among these was actually 2024's Rank 1 (Shakti Dubey) with 112, slightly higher than 2023's top score in GS1. However, ranks 2–5 in 2024 mostly scored around the 90s–100s, whereas in 2023 most were above 100 except the one dip. This suggests that 2023 toppers generally performed well in GS1 (aside from one anomaly), whereas 2024 toppers had more middle-of-the-road GS1 scores.









We see a gentle downward slope for both years as rank increases, indicating that higher-ranked candidates tend to have higher GS2 scores (unsurprisingly). However, the gap between the years is evident at the upper end: the #1–3 ranks of 2023 outscored their 2024 counterparts in GS2 by a few marks each. This could imply that the 2023 exam's GS2 was slightly more scoring or that the top candidates of 2023 had stronger Polity/IR answers. By Rank 5, the difference narrows (115 vs 113). In summary, Polity & Governance (GS2) was a highscoring section for toppers in both years, but 2023 saw a higher peak score in this paper



In 2023, most top-5 candidates had GS3 marks in the 90s, except one standout – Ruhani (AIR 5, 2023) scored 120 in GS3, the highest among these ranks, which boosted her total significantly In contrast, 2024's GS3 scores, while all below 110, were a bit more **consistent**, clustered between 86 and 108. Notably, 2024's Rank 3 (Dongre Archit) scored 108, the highest GS3 in that year's top five, nearly matching 2023's high. Meanwhile, 2024's Rank 1 and 2 scored in the high 80s/ low 90s, slightly below their 2023 counterparts (Aditya had 95 vs Shakti's 86 in GS3). The graph reflects these differences: the orange line (2024) is relatively flatter, whereas the yellow line (2023) dips and then spikes at rank 5. This suggests that GS3 was a challenging paper in both years, typically yielding lower marks than other GS papers, but 2023 allowed one top candidate to excel exceptionally (120 marks).


GS3 (Economy, Environment, S&T) = Lowest ROI (Low marks, high effort)

The Ethics paper has been a high-scoring section for top candidates in both 2023 and 2024. The graph and table show that most top-five contenders scored well above 120 in GS4. In 2023, four out of the top five achieved 127–143 in Ethics, with AIR 1 Aditya scoring 143 – one of the highest Ethics marks. In 2024, three of the top five scored in the mid-120s, and notably, AIR 4 Margi Chirag scored 128 and AIR 1 Shakti Dubey scored 141 in Ethics (virtually matching the previous year's topper). The Ethics scores for 2024 are a bit more clustered (124–141 range) whereas 2023 had one lower score (114 by AIR 5) but also a very high top score. The **trend** line for 2024 (orange) is relatively flat compared to other subjects – indicating consistent strong ethics performances for ranks 1 through 5 – and even rises slightly at rank 4. 2023's trend (yellow) starts very high at rank 1 then gradually declines



Lessons for Future UPSC Aspirants (Optional Subjects Insight):

- 1.**PSIR and Anthropology** are consistently high-scoring with average marks above **270**, making them strong choices if prepared well.
- 2.**Sociology** remains popular but shows slightly more variation—strong fundamentals and writing skills are key.
- 3. Focus on **test series + answer writing** for optional to boost performance near the 280–300 range.
- 4.Don't choose optional based on trends alone—your interest + ability to revise + scoring pattern must align.
- 5. High optional score can compensate for slightly lower GS marks—ROI is significant.

Average Total Optional Marks (UPSC CSE 2024 Toppers)





The interview process is subjective, but top candidates often score very well here. In 2023, interview scores for the top five ranged from 175 to 200, with the topper Aditya achieving a perfect 200/275. In 2024, the range was even higher – from 187 up to 210. Notably, 2024's Rank 4 (Margi) received 210 marks in the interview, which is exceptionally high and above the usual maximum seen in 2023. The graph shows the orange line (2024) peaking at rank 4, whereas the yellow line (2023) peaks at rank 1 (200) and rank 5 (193). On average, the 2024 toppers' interview scores were a bit higher: four of the five got 190 or above, compared to two out of five in 2023. In fact, 2024 saw three candidates break the **200-mark in interview** (ranks 4 and 5 above 200, and rank 1 exactly 200), whereas 2023 had only one candidate at 200 and others in the 175– 195 range. This suggests that the 2024 board interviews were generous to some top performers, which helped boost their finals totals (for example, Margi's stellar interview likely offset her lower GS/Optional scores to keep her at AIR 4). On the other hand, 2023's top cohort had a wider spread in interview scores – one candidate (AIR 2) got a relatively modest 175, while others were mid-180s to 200.


